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- EBooks saved on an eBook reader will not work after the loan period ends.
- You can’t renew, but you can borrow the same item again if it’s available.
- Deleting expired files will save space.

To Return an EBook Early

Most devices require similar steps. *NOTE: Apps do not allow you to return early.*

- First, plug your device into your computer.
- Open your eBook software on your computer.

For the Nook

- Click on “All Items.”
- Click on the “Item Options” arrow, to the left of the eBook cover.
- Click on “Return Borrowed Item.” This returns it from your computer only. To return the copy on your device, click on your device and follow the same steps.

For the Sony Reader

- Click on “Library.”
- Right click on the eBook cover.
- Select “Return Borrowed Item.” The copy on your device will automatically be returned with the copy on your computer.

Apple & Android Devices

A free app makes it easy to use eBooks on your Droid, iPhone, iPod, or iPad. Devices vary, but the steps will be similar to these.

- 1 Create an account at **adobe.com** to authorize your device.
- 2 Next, on your device, search online or in your app store for "Overdrive." Select "Overdrive Media Console."
- 3 Download and open the Droid, iPhone, or iPad app. (Droid users: Next, tap the "Menu" button.) Tap "Get Books."
- 4 Tap "Add a Website." Under "Find a Library," search for our zip code, 61820. Choose "Lincoln Trail Libraries System—Champaign Public Library Central Library."
- 5 Apple users: Tap "NSLS MyMediaMall" to open MyMediaMall. Droid users: Tap star first to save location; then tap "Library" or "NSLS MyMediaMall."
- 6 For your library (in drop-down menu), choose "Lincoln Trail Libraries System." Sign in with your 14-digit Champaign library card number and your PIN.
- 7 Find an EPUB book to borrow. If it's available, tap "Add to Cart." If it's checked out, you can place a hold.
- 8 Proceed to Checkout. Tap "Confirm Checkout," then "Download." The first time, you'll be asked for your Adobe ID. Droid users: You may need to return to Library main page, tap title, then "Download."
- 9 Your available eBooks appear in your app's "Library." Tap a book to download it to your device.

5 Steps to Using Library eBooks

Most devices follow procedures similar to these. Some may require firmware updates. See your device's website for specific help. (For phones and iPads, use instructions at left. Please note that Kindles are not compatible with library eBooks.)

1 Download eBook Software

First, you need free **Adobe Digital Editions** software. (Sony Reader users need the **Sony Reader Library**, plus firmware updates, available at <http://ebookstore.sony.com/download>)

- Start on our website, **champaign.org**.
- Click "Catalog," then click the gray "MediaMall Downloads" tab.
- Scroll down the MyMediaMall homepage to Digital Software (at lower left). Click on "Adobe Digital Editions."
- Click on "Get Adobe Digital Editions."
- Click on the Adobe Digital Editions Installer "Launch" button. Follow instructions.

2 Go to MyMediaMall

- Start on our website, **champaign.org**.
- Click "Catalog," then click the gray "MediaMall Downloads" tab.

3 Three Ways to Browse

First, sign in. Use your Champaign library card number and PIN. This gives you easy access to additional "Advantage" titles, available only to our patrons.



1. "Quick Search" for a title, author, or subject.
For each item, there's a list of available formats or compatible devices:



2. OR browse by type of book (mystery, romance, business, children's fiction, etc.).
3. OR browse specific formats that work on your device such as EPUB, PDF, or Mobipocket.

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If the eBook Is Available

- Choose "Add to Cart."
- Click "Proceed to Checkout."
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- Select your library. NOTE: Choose "Lincoln Trail Libraries System."
- Choose 7- or 14-day checkout.
- Check out up to 5 items.

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- Click "Place a Hold." (The "Add to Cart" option will not show.) Enter your e-mail. You'll be notified when the item is available.
- Place up to 7 items on hold.

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- Click the "Download" button.
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- Select the eBook you want, and drag it to your eBook reader. (Nook users, your eBooks may be saved in a "My Documents" or "My Files" folder.)
- Safely remove your reader before unplugging it from the computer.

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
